Atwood City Council met in **special session** August 1, 2017 at City Hall. The Honorable Mayor Tim Colgan called the meeting to order at 5:15 PM. Others present were Councilmembers Gary Fisher, Dietrich Kastens, and Mark Mosley; City Clerk Keri Riener; City Attorney Charles Peckham and Legal Intern Austin Bork. Councilmembers Sandy Mulligan and Mark Vrbas, Chief Police Brian Withington, City Superintendent Rick Kramer and Rosalie Ross of the Rawlins County Square Deal were absent. Jared Hurst, Rawlins County Economic Development Board President attended the Special Meeting on behalf of the RCED Board.

The **Agenda** was approved as presented on motion of Councilman Gary Fisher, seconded by Councilman Mark Mosley, approved by all.

The purpose of the special meeting was reviewing the revised **Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Atwood and Rawlins County Economic Development Board**. The document lists the City of Atwood as legal owner of Greason Industrial Park, only as a stakeholder. Rawlins County Economic Development, Inc. has been the entity responsible for handling sale and development of the property and will continue in that manner. Other agreements between the two parties regarding maintenance, mowing, grant action, taxes, monetary payments and general responsibilities were outlined as well. Following discussion of the document information, Councilman Mosley moved to **approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Atwood and Rawlins County Economic Development Inc. as written**, Councilman Dietrich Kastens seconded, approved by all. Mayor Colgan and RCED Board President Jared Hurst signed the agreement.

Councilman Fisher moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Kastens. The meeting adjourned at 5:20 PM.
